Parking lot and park at the back for games, etc. | Book in advance through the office. Book early as the space books up quickly. |
| Day or Evening Use | Free! | If your unit would like to have your enrollment/advancement ceremony, Halloween or Christmas party or just a meeting in the basement. | Book in advance through the office. |
| Non-Guiding Use | | No longer permitted due to city bylaw pertaining to our building. | |
| Camp | \$30 booking fee/site (non-refundable) and \$5+GST*/person/night: Note! 50% of booking fee paid will apply to ground fees! | Booking camp at Trefoil Trails, Pike Lake, is done through the office. Info regarding what is available at camp is on the website, via the Trefoil Trails tab. | If you need tents for camp, inquire at the time of booking. |
